A message from Mrs. Denham

We have been asked to send out letters by our Education Welfare Officer (EWO) to those parents whose children have below 95% attendance. These should have been sent home today. Our EWO monitors the attendance of all pupils carefully and asks us as school staff to do all we can to ensure pupils attend school every day. However, we really appreciate that if your child is ill there is nothing you can do about it and they have to be off school. We discuss this with the EWO and explain absences wherever we can.

If a parents asks for their child to have an exceptional absence from school, I always appreciate it when parents come and discuss this with me beforehand. A detailed covering letter has always allowed us to have discussions with the EWO that are acceptable.

At present we have 24 pupils with below 95% attendance but the wonderful news is that 6 pupils have 100% attendance - a huge well done to Tabitha Andrews, Summah Barrow, Billy Dudden, Reegan Fowler, Charlie Marshall and Adam Rashid.
