Remember that no parental controls are perfect, consider the following points:

- View programmes and videos together
- Use 'safe search' mode Google and YouTube
- Use 'safe search engines' such as Swiggle

Is your child playing online games? Is the game your child playing age appropriate? Do you know the risks of online games?



The risks of playing online games include:

- Accidentally viewing inappropriate or upsetting material
- Playing games with people they don't know
- Wanting to play the game(s) all the time

The NSPCC's recommendations include:

- Always check the PEGI age ratings
- Find out how to mute, block and report
- Use parental controls
