Even if they already have siblings at the school you must apply online at www.devon.gov.uk/admissionsonline from 15th November, 2015 to 15th January, 2016.

If you can't apply online you can get a copy of the First Step Booklet by calling the Education Helpline on 0345 155 1019 or email <u>primaryschooladmissions@devon.gov.uk</u>.

Even if you have already given details to a primary school, you must apply for a place through the Admissions Team. This is the only way to apply; other forms or lists held by schools will not count.
