Dear parents and carers

We wish you a warm welcome back to the summer term. I hope you all had a restful Easter holiday and enjoyed the beautiful weather. It was lovely to return to school with all the children and staff ready to start a new term, a new topic and raring to get started.

We are so hopeful and looking forward to getting back to the new normal with the COVID roadmap allowing us to restart trips, visitor and sporting events again after half term. The children and staff have missed them all so much.

As the weather becomes warmer and sunnier please can I remind you to send your child into school with a full named water bottle, sunscreen (in a named bottle) and a sun hat for them to wear at playtimes and lunchtimes.

ARRIVAL TIME FOR KS1 & KS2:

KS2 children (Foxes and Squirrels) to arrive from 8.30am but they MUST be in school by 8.45am.

KS1 children (Hedgehogs and Robins) to arrive from 8.40am but they MUST be in school by 8.50am

Sadly, parents still won't be allowed on the playground. Instead children will go straight into their classrooms as soon as they arrive through the gate. A member of staff will be on the gate at 8.30am and will sanitise the children's hands as normal.

If a parent has siblings in both KS1 and KS2, they can arrive promptly by 8.40am and children will be in school by the needed time.

We hope you agree that this is more helpful for parents, still gives a staggered start to hopefully help alleviate congestion in the car park and ensures every child is in school ready to learn by 8.50am.

Health and Safety concern – magnet toys

You may already be aware of a recent "playground craze" toy consisting of very small, powerful round magnets. They are brightly coloured, look like sweets, are traded on the playground and easily hidden. These have caused severe injuries to children when swallowed, deliberately, or more commonly accidentally, when doing tricks that involve putting some of them in the mouth with more on the outside of the cheek. A recent incident in the County left a child in hospital. There are numerous newspaper reports of children undergoing significant abdominal surgery to have the magnets removed to avoid serious damage being done because they clump together around internal tissue causing tears.

We suggest you raise awareness for children and parents of the dangers of putting these balls in the mouth and you may want to control how these are coming into school
