A message from Mrs. Hammond

This week I have managed to get out and about into the classrooms and it has been lovely to see the children so engaged and enjoying their learning. I particularly enjoyed a visit to Robins class where they were designing and making castles of their very own. I was very much taken with a beautiful pink and rainbow design – the children's creativity and enthusiasm for this task was contagious and I wished I could have stayed longer to make one of my own. I certainly left the room feeling some castle envy. In Hedgehogs class, I enjoyed listening to the children sharing their learning about WWII, it is clearly a topic they are enthralled by. The level of vocabulary and description being used was absolutely amazing. In Foxes class, the children were deep diving into the role the Ancient Greeks played in the creation of the Olympic games. Some surprise was had when they discovered how much the games have changed over the years. In Squirrel's class we have had a busy week of testing – so not quite as exciting as other classes. Reminders

Start time and the morning gate

In light of some changes to safeguarding we will be making some alterations to the way we manage the gate at the start of the day.

Your child's start of the day time will remain the same: KS2 children (years 3,4,5,6) who do not have any KS1 siblings in the school are to arrive at 8:30am. KS1 (reception, years 1 &2) and KS2 siblings are to arrive at 8:40am and those children in KS1 who do not have any other siblings in the school are to arrive at 8:50am.

However, the gate will now be locked and class registration will be closed at 9am. If you arrive after this time you will have to ring the bell at the gate. Mrs. Palmer will then buzz you and your child onto the school site, where you will have to come to the office, sign them in and provide their lunch choice.

Absence Requests

Just a reminder that any absence requests from school during term time will be unauthorised unless evidence suggests that the absence required is due to exceptional and unavoidable circumstances.

New Education Mental Health Programme in School

We are delighted to be supporting a new Educational Mental Health programme for our children and families in school.

Miss. Williamson will be the lead worker for the school and is busy working alongside Debbie, our Education Mental Health Practitioner, planning the best way the programme can support the school, its pupils and their families. Below is an introduction from Debbie and a link to a survey that we would like you to complete so we can better plan how Miss. Williamson can be used within this role.

I am Debbie Newman, an Education Mental Health Practitioner (EMHP for short!) working with Holywell. I am part of the Mental Health Support Team (MHST) for schools in Child & Family Health Devon.

MHST deliver evidence based individual and group interventions for young people who need extra support for mild to moderate anxiety or low mood. We also work with staff and whole classes delivering workshops and training around mental health and promoting positive emotional wellbeing at your child's school.

In order for our team to help the school develop targets for the coming year in regards to mental health provision, it's really important that we get the views of everyone involved in school life – staff, governors, pupils and parents. If you could take the time (around 5 minutes) to fill in this online survey, it would be really useful in helping us develop Holywell's provision for your child.
