Message from Mrs. Lowrey

This year, I am sure that we will also have a real mix of emotions among our children as we also begin to talk more about returning to Holywell. This week we were visited by Rachel Wood from the mental health for schools team, who spoke to the children about their emotions and the skills that they may have developed through the journey that we have been on. They may feel confident to use some of this language at home, so please do know that it is very normal to feel mixtures of emotions and we will support them over the coming weeks and on return.

We are also planning a celebration event back at Holywell on Wednesday 8th January. I am delighted that Park and Pilton year 7 children will be invited to attend and see their old school. The event is intended to be an opportunity to see the new classroom(s) and the changes that have been made. I am also now able to share that the transport is organised to bring all children to the Christingle service at Tawstock church. Free School Meals

Check if your child can get free school meals and additional funding support.

All children in reception, year 1 and year 2 at state schools in England automatically get free school meals. However, parents and guardians are encouraged to apply for free school meals when they enrol their child in school, as this can help their child's school to attract additional 'pupil premium' funding to support learning. From year 3 onwards, children whose parents are getting any of the following are entitled to free school meals:

- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods).
- Income Support (IS).
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance (IBJSA).
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (IRESA).
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit.
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income that does not exceed £16,190).
- Working Tax Credit run-on (the payment you get for a further 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit).

How to apply

Apply through the <u>Devon Citizens Portal</u>. This is the quickest and easiest way to apply and will result in you getting an instant decision. Alternatively, call the Education Helpline on 0345 155 1019.
